

Handyman – we will send in our hardworking team to assist with jobs that help promote safety and security in an older person's home. There are no labour charges and we only pass on the direct costs of materials used!

Enhancing Lives – our team can help older people and their carers ensure they are getting the correct benefits and anything else, like blue badges or access to benevolent funds, that they are entitled to receive!

Home Support – Our superb team of workers can assist older people with shopping, housework, laundry and other domestic tasks to enable them to remain safe at home for longer! This is a regular chargeable service.

Getting On – We have an excellent group of volunteers who are able to visit or phone lonely older people for some much needed company and provide conversation on a regular basis.

We are always looking for volunteers to support lonely older people so please contact us if you can help!

We are also happy to discuss any other issues older people or their carers might be facing and will always look to help, or find the appropriate person or organisation to assist, where we can!

We also offer seasonally dependent services such as gardening and energy support/heater loans for older people. In addition to this we offer specialised support for people leaving hospital (or who have been discharged in the last 28 days) to help them return and stay at home safely.
